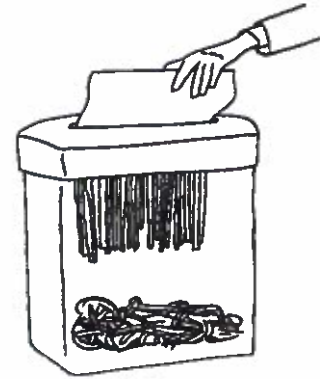

Re: Recycling Opportunities



Now that tax season is behind us, we will place the large locked totes in the hallway near the Key Pad 1 entrance on the first floor. Feel free to dispose of paper documents that require confidential destruction. All shredding is done offsite by a locally owned company, *Certified Document Destruction & Recycling*.

The totes will remain in this location from now until May 31, 2019.

Although The Highlands is not hosting a formal electronics recycling event this spring, we may be able to help you dispose of old equipment such as computers and accessories, office and entertainment equipment, small home appliances, and mobile devices. **There will be a fee involved**, determined by weight and payable to Sunnking. As a rule of thumb, you can expect to pay about 50 cents a pound for most items, while the cost for recycling an old tube TV is \$1.50 per pound. Go to sunnking.com to see a list of acceptable items.

If you have electronic scrap to recycle, call the Hospitality Desk at 586-7600 on or before May 31st to make your request known.
